a sudden, impulsive action or notion
Pearl often acts with *caprice*.

imperious

adjective | im•pe•ri•ous (im-peer-ee-us)
commanding; urgent

Pearl demanded to be taken up in arms, but was soon as *imperious* to be set down again.
