adjective | im•per•turb•able (im-purr-TURB-uh-bul) marked by extreme calm, impassivity, steadiness

adjective | ob•strep•er•ous (ob-STREP-uh-russ)
 marked by unruly or aggressive noisiness
 The citizens of the village could not excuse Pearl's obstreperous behavior.
