deprecating

adjective | dep•re•cat•ing (DEP-rah-kate-ing)

tending or serving to disparage or belittle someone or something

Though he claimed to be humane, Haley had a very *deprecating* attitude towards the slaves.

facetious

adjective | fa•ce•tious (fah-SEE-shus)

joking or jesting often inappropriately

Sam and Andy seem to want to help Haley, but can't help being *facetious* toward him.
