supplicate

verb | sup•pli•cate

to make a humble entreaty; to ask for humbly and earnestly

The students *supplicated* the teacher for an extension on the due date.

indolent

adjective | in•do•lent

averse to activity, effort or movement; habitually lazy

St. Clare was *indolent* and careless of money.
