**discerning**

*adjective* | dis•cern•ing(diss-SERN-ing)  
**exhibiting keen insight and good judgment; perceptive**

**supercilious**

*adj* | sup•er•cil•i•ous (soup-er-SILL-ee-us)  
**feeling or showing haughty disdain**
