Formatting/5	<ul> <li>□ 12-point Times New Roman font</li> <li>□ Double spaced with no extra space between paragraphs</li> <li>□ Heading: Correctly formatted heading w/o any extra spaces between lines (1st page only)</li> <li>□ Header: Last name and page number appear in the top right corner of every page</li> <li>□ Margins are set to 1 inch on all sides</li> <li>□ Begins with a creative title that relates to topic and is properly centered and formatted</li> </ul>
Introduction/10	<ul> <li>□ Begins with an attention getter ("hook") that draws the reader in</li> <li>□ 2 - 3 sentences clearly and effectively connect hook to thesis</li> <li>□ Thesis statement, which clearly communicates the purpose of paper, is the last sentence of introduction</li> <li>□ Introduction has a minimum of five sentences, OR four complex, well-written sentences that fully establish the tone of the paper and fulfill the above requirements</li> </ul>
Body Paragraphs /40	<ul> <li>□ Each body paragraph begins with a topic sentence that directly supports thesis</li> <li>□ Each body paragraph contains at least two examples of textual evidence that supports claim</li> <li>□ Evidence's source is introduced via author and/or title the first time source is used</li> <li>□ Quotes are properly integrated into writing—no dropped quotes</li> <li>□ At least two sentences of analysis follow each quote/evidence</li> <li>□ Analysis connects the quote to the topic sentence</li> <li>□ Analysis does not simply rephrase quote, but explains WHY it is important</li> <li>□ Avoids "This quote shows" phrasing</li> <li>□ Each body paragraph uses transitions between claims/evidence as well as between paragraphs</li> <li>□ Uses strong, formal wording, including:</li> <li>□ Few be-verbs (am, is, are, was, were, be, being, been)</li> <li>□ No contractions</li> <li>□ No "I" or "you" or "we"—use third person only</li> <li>□ No "I" or "you" or "we"—use third person only</li> <li>□ Varied sentence openers (multiple sentences in the same paragraph do not start with the same word)</li> </ul>
In-text Citations /10	<ul> <li>□ Each body paragraph contains a minimum of 2 citations from 2 different sources</li> <li>□ If the author's name is not part of the integrated quote, the name appears as part of the parenthetical citation (Jones 32).</li> <li>□ If sources have a page number, it is included as a parenthetical citation (32).</li> <li>□ Citations direct reader back to the first word of Works Cited entry</li> </ul>

Counter/ Refutation/10	<ul> <li>□ Includes least one counterargument/refutation paragraph</li> <li>□ Clearly presents counterargument as opposing paper's main argument, using phrasing such as "Some may argue" or "Others claim that"</li> <li>□ Provides evidence for counterargument claim, properly integrated and cited</li> <li>□ Fully refutes counterargument, transitioning to make clear of <i>turn back</i> to paper's main argument</li> <li>□ Evidence to support the <i>turn back</i> included (i.e. evidence to support the thesis)</li> </ul>
Conclusion/10	<ul> <li>□ First sentence of conclusion is re-stated thesis, using different words to repeat the main idea of thesis claim</li> <li>□ Conclusion summarizes main points explored in body paragraphs</li> <li>□ Conclusion ends with a memorable clincher statement</li> </ul>
Works Cited Page	<ul> <li>□ Works Cited page is on a separate page, numbered as the last page of document</li> <li>□ Works Cited page is properly formatted: double spaced, properly punctuated, using a hanging indent</li> <li>□ Works Cited page is properly alphabetized (by first word of entry)</li> <li>□ Uses correct number of sources, including at least one book and a database article</li> <li>□ Uses correct MLA format for WC entries</li> </ul>
Details/5	<ul> <li>□ Paper is at least 1500 words (not counting Works Cited page)</li> <li>□ Paper is neatly typed, spell-checked, and free of errors</li> <li>□ Includes all items necessary for final paper submission, listed below</li> </ul>
